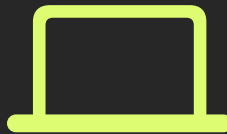
The missing remote control app for Ableton Live.

How Grip works

Grip (iPhone) connects with Wi-Fi to Grip (Mac),
to control Ableton Live.

Ableton Live (Mac)

1. Install Grip on your Mac

1 Download

Download Grip for Mac.

2 Install

Drag **Grip** to your Applications folder.

3 Open Grip

macOS will prompt you to grant permissions for Grip to run in the background, so you don't even need the Grip app open on your Mac.

4 Check the setup

Grip automatically installs a Control Surface script for Ableton Live. Double-check in the Grip window that it's installed.

2. Install Grip on your iPhone

1 Get Grip from the App Store

Search for **Grip: Control Ableton Live** on the App Store.

2 Install

Install Grip from the App Store.

3. Set up Ableton Live

Grip is considered a **control surface** for Live, just like Push or any MIDI controller.

1 Open Live

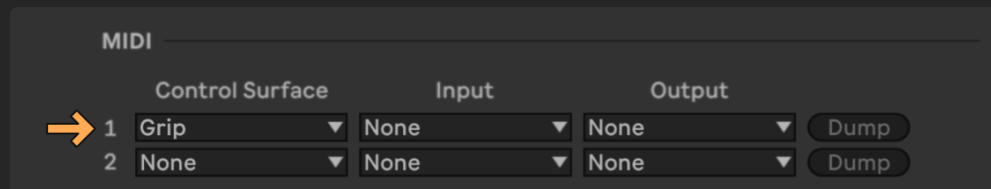
Open Live on the same Mac as the Grip app.

2 Open Settings

Go to **Live** → **Settings** (or press ⌘,))

3 Choose Grip as a Control Surface

In the **Link, Tempo & MIDI** tab, choose **Grip** as a Control Surface.



4. Connect from iPhone

1 Get on Wi-Fi

Make sure your iPhone and Mac are on the same Wi-Fi network.

2 Open Grip for iPhone

Open Grip on your iPhone. It should connect automatically. If it doesn't, check the Grip app on your Mac.
